After a brief discussion on the agenda the following resolutions have been passed by the Committee -

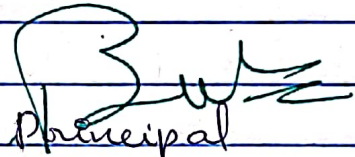
1. To seek permission from the principal to organize different activities from 01/06/2023 to 05/06/2023 at our college campus and outside the campus.

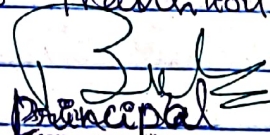
Therefore be it resolved that :

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Plantation

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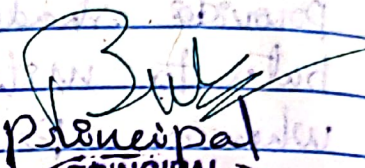
Date: 03/03/2023
