<b>Objective of the Event</b>	To raise awareness about the dowry system and educate students on the Dowry Prohibition Act and its implications.
<b>Description of the event</b>	Anti Dowry Day was celebrated at Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam, on November 26, 2022. The event was organized by the IQAC and the Department of Political Science. The chief guest for the event was R. Sanyasi Naidu, Senior Civil Judge, who shared valuable insights about the dowry system and the Dowry Prohibition Act. He emphasized that dowry is a social evil prevalent in India and educated students about the Indian law enacted on May 1, 1961, to prevent the giving or receiving of a dowry. Under the Dowry Prohibition Act, dowry includes property, goods, or money given by either party to the marriage, by the parents of either party, or by anyone else in connection with the marriage. He highlighted that it is an offense to both take and give dowry. Principal Dr. P. Surekha also attended as a special guest and shared her insights on the issue of dowry. The event saw the participation of 116 students, who were informed about the legal and social implications of the dowry system.

<p><b>Out come of the Event</b></p>	<p>Participants gained a thorough understanding of the dowry system and the Dowry Prohibition Act. The event successfully raised awareness about the legal consequences of dowry and encouraged students to stand against this social evil. The informative sessions by the Senior Civil Judge and the Principal helped in fostering a sense of responsibility among students to prevent dowry practices in their communities.</p>
