<b>Objective of the Event</b>	To raise awareness about the significance of Human Rights Day and Indian Constitution Day, and to honor the contributions of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar.
<b>Description of the event</b>	<p>Indian Constitution Day and International Human Rights Day were celebrated at Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam, on December 10, 2022. The event was organized by the Department of Economics and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). Srikakulam District Joint Collector Sri. K. Naveen, IAS, attended as the chief guest.</p> <p>In his speech, Sri. K. Naveen highlighted that Human Rights Day is observed every year on December 10, the day the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in 1948. The formal inception of Human Rights Day dates back to 1950 when the Assembly passed resolution 423 (V) inviting all States and interested organizations to adopt December 10 of each year as Human Rights Day.</p> <p>He also spoke about the Indian Constitution, adopted on November 26, 1949, and effective from January 26, 1950. The Indian Constitution has been successfully guiding the path and process of India since then. The celebration aimed to spread awareness of the importance of the Indian Constitution and to acknowledge the contributions of its architect, Dr. B. R.</p>

	Ambedkar. The year-long activities for the celebration of Constitution Day have been ongoing since November 26, 2019, across India.
