Objective of the Event	To create awareness among students about the Anti Ragging Act and its consequences.
Description of the event	<p>On August 20, 2019, an Awareness Programme on the Anti Ragging Act was organized by the Anti Ragging Cell at Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam. The event aimed to educate students about the serious implications of ragging and the legal consequences under the Anti Ragging Act.</p> <p>Sri Ravi Kumar, II Town Sub Inspector, served as the chief guest and delivered an informative address to the students. He outlined the stringent measures in place to prevent ragging and the severe penalties for those found guilty. Emphasizing the importance of maintaining a ragging-free campus, he detailed the provisions of the Anti Ragging Act and urged students to uphold a culture of respect and dignity.</p> <p>Dr. M. Babu Rao, Principal, attended the event as a special guest. He reinforced the message by highlighting the college's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and encouraged students to report any incidents promptly. Dr. Babu Rao also discussed the support systems available within the institution to assist victims of ragging.</p> <p>The event was organized by Sri. M. Pradeep, Coordinator of the Anti Ragging Cell, and saw active participation from 85 students. The interactive session allowed students to ask</p>

	questions and clarify their doubts regarding the Anti Ragging Act.

The participation of law enforcement authorities added weight to the anti-ragging message, fostering a safer and more respectful environment on campus.
