Objective of the Event	To commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to promote constitutional values among the students and citizens.
Description of the event	On November 26, 2019, Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam, observed Constitution Day (Samvidhan Divas) to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. The event was organized by the Department of Political Science, with Dr. G. Janardhana Naidu serving as the coordinator. The event commenced with a gathering where the significance of Constitution Day was emphasized. Justice B. Gautham Prasad, Additional District Judge, attended as the chief guest, alongside Dr. M. Babu Rao, Principal of the college. In his address, Justice B. Justice Prasad also discussed the decision by the Government of India, announced by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on November 19, 2015, to officially recognize November 26th as Constitution Day. This initiative aims to enhance awareness and appreciation of the constitutional values and principles among citizens.

He reiterated the significance of Constitution Day and encouraged students to reflect on the impact of the Constitution on Indian society. The event concluded with a pledge-taking ceremony, where students and staff reaffirmed their commitment to upholding the constitutional values that define India's democratic ethos.
