| Objective of the Event | The event aimed to raise awareness about the significance of Hiroshima Day and the impact of nuclear warfare, fostering critical reflection and promoting peace among students. |

Description of the event

The Elocution on Hiroshima Day was held on August 06, 2018, in the Department of Physics Laboratory at Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam. A total of 16 students participated in the event, each delivering a prepared speech within a 5-minute timeframe. The students passionately spoke about the tragic events of Hiroshima, reflecting on the human cost of the atomic bombing and the lessons to be learned from history.

After the students had presented their speeches, L. Swarna Latha, the Incharge of the Department of Physics, addressed the participants. She emphasized the importance of Hiroshima Day, reminding everyone of the tragic events that took place on August 6, 1945, during World War II. On that day, the U.S. B-29 Super fortress Enola Gay dropped an atomic bomb code-named "Little Boy" on Hiroshima, Japan, leading to an estimated 140,000 deaths. Her speech highlighted the devastating effects of nuclear weapons and the enduring impact of the Hiroshima bombing on global consciousness.

Outcome of the Event

The event successfully deepened students' understanding of the impact of nuclear warfare and inspired them to advocate for global peace.
