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Description of the event

On 24th December 2018, the Department of Commerce at Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam, organized an Essay Writing Competition in Room No. 24 to commemorate National Consumer Day. A total of 17 students participated in the event, each writing an essay of at least 500 words on various aspects of consumer rights.

After the essays were written, Sri. H. Lakshmipathi, the coordinator of the event, addressed the students. He highlighted the significance of National Consumer Day, explaining that it is celebrated annually on 24th December to mark the approval of the Consumer Rights Act by the President of India in 1986. He emphasized that the act grants every Indian consumer six essential rights: the right to security, the right to information, the right to choose, the right to have a say, the right to grievance and redressal, and the right to consumer rights education.

The essay writing exercise helped them gain a deeper understanding of consumer protection laws and the importance of being informed and active consumers.
