| Objective of the Event | The objective of this essay writing competition was to honor the memory of Sri Potti Sri Ramulu, recognize his contributions to the Indian Independence Movement, and inspire students by discussing his legacy and commitment to the nation. |

Description of the event

On 15th December 2018, the Department of Telugu at Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam, organized an essay writing competition to commemorate the death anniversary of Sri Potti Sri Ramulu. The event saw the participation of 14 students, who were required to write essays in Telugu on the life and legacy of Sri Potti Sri Ramulu, focusing on his role in India's freedom struggle.

After the essay writing session, the organizer of the event, Sri P. Narayana Rao, addressed the students, providing a detailed account of Sreeramulu's life. He highlighted Sreeramulu's active participation in the Indian Independence Movement, including his involvement in the Salt Satyagraha in 1930 and multiple imprisonments for his role in the Satyagraha and Quit India campaign between 1941 and 1942. Sri P. Narayana Rao also spoke about Sreeramulu's efforts in town revitalization projects across various regions and his dedication to the cause, as recognized by Mahatma Gandhi, who famously said that with eleven more followers like Sreeramulu, India could achieve liberation from British rule within a year.
