

Description of the event

On the occasion of the Death Anniversary of Alluri Seetharama Raju, the Department of Telugu organized an elocution competition. A total of 17 students participated in the event, delivering speeches in Telugu with great enthusiasm. Each participant spoke for a minimum of 5 minutes, showcasing their deep respect for the revolutionary leader.

After the elocution, the organizer of the event, Sri. P. Narayana Rao, addressed the students, highlighting the remarkable achievements of Alluri Seetharama Raju. He emphasized that Alluri Seetharama Raju was one of the few Indian revolutionaries who developed a mass base and led a sustained armed struggle against the British colonial powers from 1922 to 1924. Adopting guerrilla tactics, he led hundreds of tribals, mostly Koyas, in this resistance. Despite the eventual suppression of the rebellion by the British, Alluri Seetharama Raju's legacy lives on as a symbol of courage and resistance. Sri. P. Narayana Rao narrated how Alluri Seetharama Raju was captured, tortured, and ultimately shot dead on May 7, 1924, in Krishna Devi Pet village, marking one of the earliest encounter killings in modern India.

Outcome of the Event

The event was successful in instilling a sense of pride and historical awareness among the students. They gained a deeper understanding of the contributions and sacrifices made by Alluri Seetharama Raju and the significance of his struggle in the larger context of India's fight for independence.
