

District Resource Centre:

To bridge the gap of interconnectivity among the government degree colleges spread all over the district and to overcome the constraints facing through sharing of resources and collective activities government has taken a decision to develop a well-established college in the district into a District Resource Centre. The College was developed into a District Resource Centre (DRC) to network all the 15 Govt. Degree Colleges in Srikakulam district. The executive committee with principal, Govt. Degree College (Men), Srikakulam as chairperson and Principals of Govt. Degree Colleges in the district as members was constituted on 11.09.2007. It rendered its services successfully from September, 2007 to December 2019. As there was no regular principal the DRC status was temporarily allotted to another college, again in December 2021 after Dr. P. Surekha was appointed as regular principal Government Degree College (M) was re nominated as Identified College/DRC.

The DRC provides resource persons to the other Colleges to deliver lectures to give academic support and progression to the students of the rural Colleges through faculty exchange programme. It also gives coaching to the final year pass out students to appear for various competitive and entrance examinations.

District Resource Center (DRC) meeting with all the Principals in the District on second working day of the month and various administrative and academic matters are discussed during these meetings and appropriate resolutions are accepted to allow participative management.

Recently virtual labs are launched in all Govt. Degree Colleges and audio visual lessons are transmitted to other colleges by senior faculty members of the college.
