Objective of the Event	The objective of this event was to conduct an orientation program for new students and their parents, aiming to make them understand and feel comfortable with college life as they transition from high school. It provided guidance, information, and motivation to create a welcoming and inspiring environment for their higher education journey.
Description of the event	
<p>On July 29th, 2018, our college started a three-day orientation program for new students. Going from high school to college can be a big change and a bit challenging for students. They come from different backgrounds and are entering a new, unfamiliar environment. To help them adjust, we have an induction program with different activities.</p> <p>The schedule of the programme is went this way :-</p> <p>On the first day, we took the students & their parents on a campus tour to show them all the resources available, like the library and laboratories. After that, inspiring guest speakers provided an orientation session.</p> <p>On the second day, our Principal, department heads, NSS (National Service Scheme) Program Officers, and NCC (National Cadet Corps) Lieutenant gave motivational speeches to help the new students & parents understand more about college and student life in higher education. Finally, on the third day, we had mentoring sessions and wrapped things up with a closing ceremony. We gave newcomers a random opportunity to discover their hidden talents. The students showcased their hidden skills, with some dancing and others singing. This talent exploration segment encouraged more interaction among the students. The students with their parents actively participated and gained valuable knowledge from this induction program. This program assisted both students and parents in resolving any doubts about college life and recognizing the</p>	

significance of their educational journey during these years. We concluded with a valedictory session in which both parents and students took an active part.
