


Brief Report	Sanskrit verbs can be crosslinked in one of three ways: first, second, or third person. There are three numerical forms for verbs: singular, dual, and plural. There are ten tenses and three voices for verbs: active, middle, and passive. There are eight cases: nominative, vocative, accusative, instrumental, dative, ablative, genitive, and locative; three genders: masculine, feminine, and neuter; and three genders: masculine, feminine, and neuter. This vast distribution of words makes Sanskrit applications very specific and formulative.
