

Allasani Peddana, Nandi Timmana, Durjati, Madaiyagari Mallana, Ayyalaraja Ramabhadra, Tenali Ramakrishna, Pingali Surana, Ramarajabhushan have published great treatises. Srikrishna Devaraya, who is known as the supreme literary figure, wrote the literary work Amuktamalayada.
