**I. FORMATION OF STUDENT WELFARE UNION (SWU)**

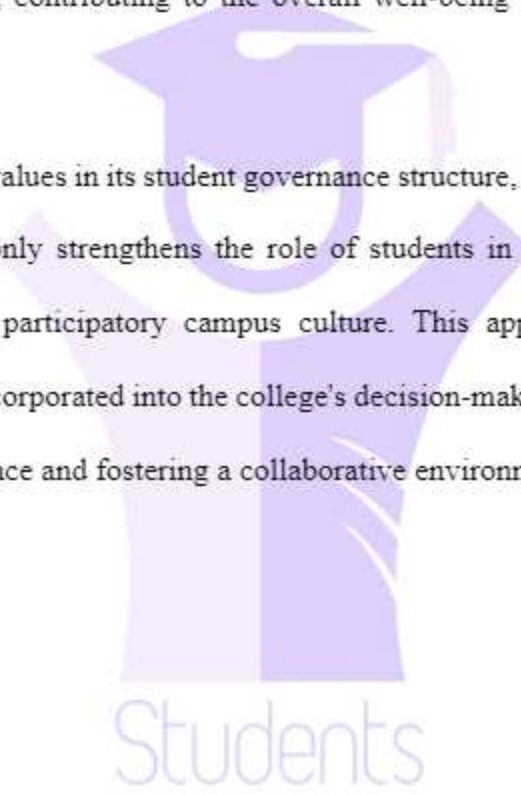

## **POLICY FOR INCLUSION OF STUDENTS IN GOVERNANCE**

### **1. PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the active participation of students in the governance of Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam. This policy aims to promote transparency, accountability, and inclusivity in decision-making processes while fostering leadership skills among students.

### **2. OBJECTIVES:**

- To include student perspectives in institutional governance.
- To enhance the quality of decision-making through diverse inputs.
- To develop a sense of ownership and responsibility among students.
- To cultivate leadership and participatory skills among students.

### **3. SCOPE:**

This policy applies to all students enrolled in Government Degree College for Men, Srikakulam, across all programs and departments.

### **4. STUDENT REPRESENTATION:**

#### **A. STUDENT WELFARE UNION (SWU):**

The Student Welfare Union will consist of elected representatives from each department. The structure of the SWU will include:

- Principal (Chairman)
- One faculty member nominated by the Principal (Convener)
- National Service Scheme Programme Officer
- One student from each class as Class Representative (CR), chosen based on academic merit and engagement in full-time studies. Among the CRs, elections will be conducted to select 10 CRs as SWU Coordinators.
- Sports Coordinator: One student from each of the following activities, nominated by the Principal: Sports, National Service Scheme, and Adult Education & Cultural Activities.
- Two female students nominated by the Principal, with priority given to those from SC/ST, De-notified Tribes, or OBCs.
- The student members of the SWU shall elect from among themselves the President and Secretary of the Students Council.

## **B. COMMITTEES AND BOARDS:**

Include student representatives in key institutional committees and boards such as:

- College Planning and Development Council (CPDC)
- Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)
- Central Purchase and Audit Committee
- UGC & RUSA Committee
- Examination and Time Table Committees
- Attendance and Magazine Committee
- Scholarship Committee
- Women Empowerment Cell
- Student Grievance & Redressal Committee
- Anti-Ragging and Discipline Committee
- Games & Sports, Library, and Cultural Committees
- SC & ST, OBC, Minority Cells, and Differently Abled Students Welfare Committee

## **5. ELECTION AND SELECTION PROCESS:**

- **Elections:** Conduct annual elections for the Student Welfare Union transparently and democratically. All enrolled students are eligible to vote and run for positions.
- **Selection:** Appoint student representatives to various committees based on nominations from the Student Council and faculty recommendations.

## **6. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The CRs and SWU representatives will act as the interface between students and the administration, working to identify and address concerns that affect the student community. Their roles include:

- Conducting meetings to discuss student issues and contribute to institutional improvement.
- Planning academic activities and developing student leadership skills.
- Organizing cultural events such as Farewell and Freshers' celebrations.
- Providing input on financial policies related to student activities, including industrial visits and projects.
- Reviewing syllabus completion for each class at the end of each semester.
- Overseeing activities and events related to student development, with funding from the institution and, in some cases, from Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University, Srikakulam.

## **7. MEETINGS AND COMMUNICATION:**

- **Regular Meetings:** Schedule regular meetings of the Student Welfare Union and other committees with student representatives to discuss ongoing issues and initiatives.
- **Open Forums:** Organize open forums and town hall meetings to gather feedback from the broader student body and address their concerns.

## 8. TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT:

- **Leadership Training:** Provide leadership training and workshops for elected and appointed student representatives to enhance their governance skills.
- **Mentorship:** Establish a mentorship program where faculty members guide student leaders in their roles and responsibilities.

- **Annual Review:** Conduct an annual review of the policy's effectiveness and make necessary adjustments based on feedback from students and faculty.

## STUDENT WELFARE UNION (SWU) ELECTION POLICY

### PURPOSE:

To establish a structured and fair process for the election of the Student Welfare Union (SWU), ensuring active student participation in college activities and effective representation of student interests.

**1. OVERVIEW:** The Student Welfare Union (SWU) aims to involve students in academic, administrative, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities, enhancing their interpersonal, leadership, and managerial skills. This policy outlines the election process for SWU members, including Class Representatives (CRs) and office bearers.

### 2. SWU STRUCTURE:

- **Principal** - Chairman
- **SWU Convener** - A faculty member nominated by the Principal
- **National Service Scheme (NSS) Programme Officer**
- **Class Representatives (CRs)** - One student from each class, nominated by the Principal based on academic merit
- **SWU Coordinators** - Ten CRs elected by their peers
- **Special Representatives:**
  - **Sports Coordinator** - One student for sports activities
  - **NSS Coordinator**
  - **Adult Education & Cultural Activities Coordinator**
- **Lady Representatives** - Two female students, ensuring representation from SC/ST/OBC categories

### 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CLASS REPRESENTATIVES (CRS):

- Must be a full-time student of the college
- Should have shown academic merit in the preceding year's examinations

#### 4. ELECTION PROCESS:

- **Nomination:** CRs are nominated by the Principal.
- **Election of Coordinators:** CRs elect 10 SWU Coordinators from among themselves.
- **Election of Office Bearers:** SWU members elect the President, Secretary, Vice President, Treasurer, Joint Secretaries (Sciences and Arts & Commerce), Lady Representatives (Sciences and Arts & Commerce), Cultural Secretary, and Sports Secretary from among the elected Coordinators and Representatives.

#### 5. ELECTION SCHEDULE:

- The date of the election is fixed annually by the Principal.
- Detailed procedures and instructions for the election are provided by the SWU Convener.

#### 6. RESPONSIBILITIES OF SWU MEMBERS:

- Represent student interests and act as a liaison between students and administration.
- Participate in meetings to address student issues and contribute to institutional improvement.
- Plan and organize academic, cultural, and sports events.
- Assist in the review of syllabus completion and other academic activities.
- Develop leadership and governance skills.


#### 7. FUNDING AND SUPPORT:

- SWU activities are primarily funded by the college.
- Some events, such as NSS or university-level programs, may receive additional funding from Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University, Srikakulam.

#### 8. IMPLEMENTATION AND REVIEW:

- The SWU Convener oversees the election process and ensures compliance with this policy.
- The policy is reviewed annually by the SWU faculty committee to incorporate necessary changes and improvements.

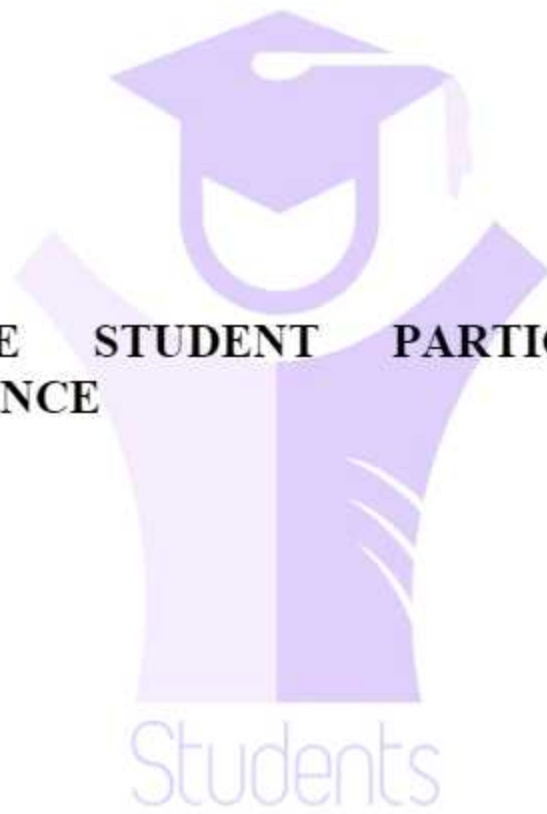

## **Objective**

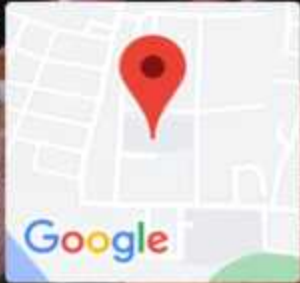
