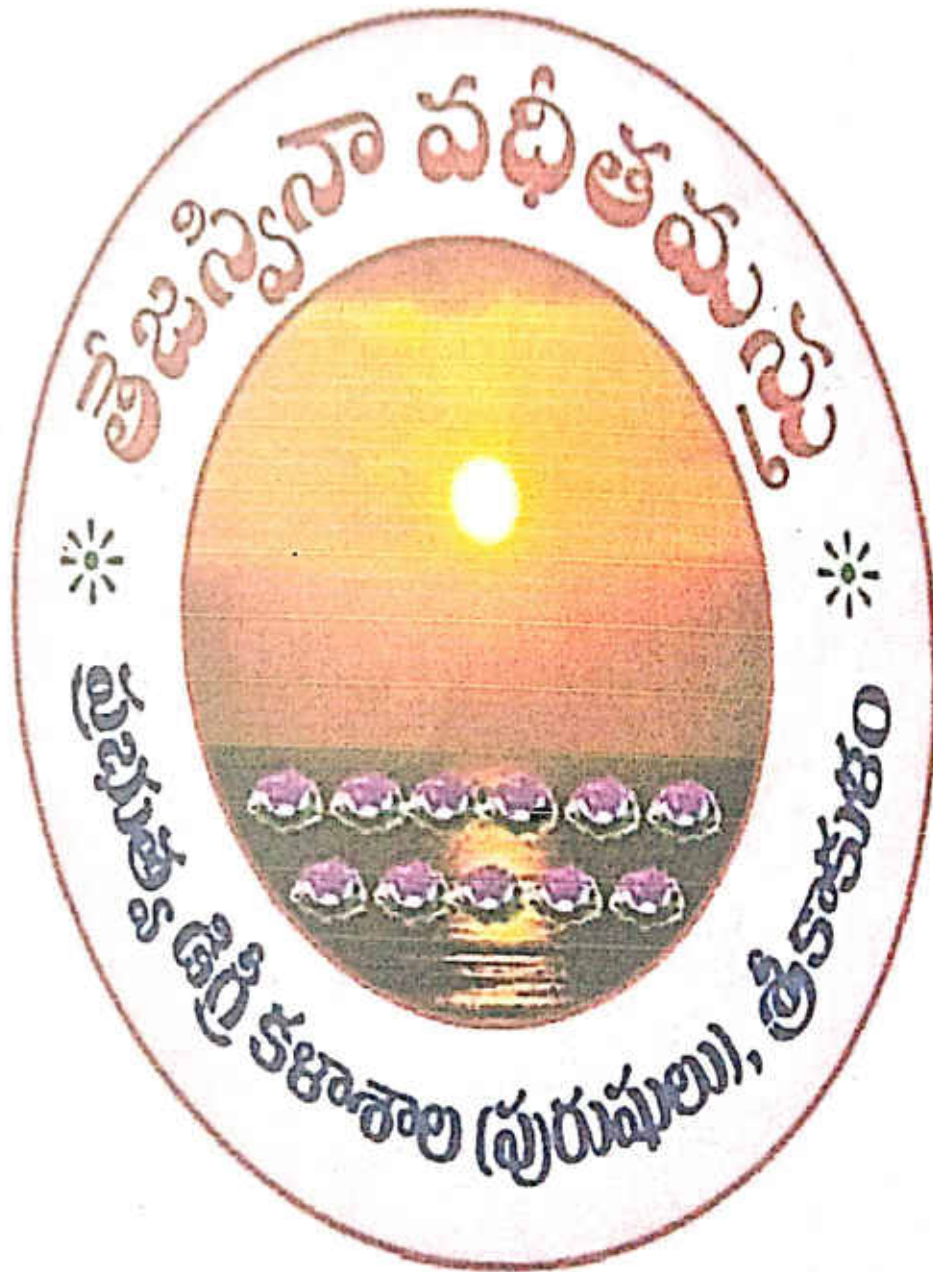

Describe the problems you have identified in the community

In the village named Singalafeta. The major problem on which people mainly complained is Damaged Roads and sanitation.

This village doesn't even contain a dump yard. The waste in the village gets contaminated and because of this many dangerous diseases are being spread.

The drainage always get stuck and flows on the road and gives stinky smell all over the area.

This village have cement and mud road. At the time of rainy season it becomes a very difficult task to the villagers to travel and even the water stay in the pits for a very long time.

Short-term and long term action plan for possible solutions for the problems identified and that could be recommended to the concerned authorities for implementation.

* Govt. should provide some vans to collect the waste for every 2 or 3 days.

* People should take care about their surroundings without any contamination.

* They need to practise several schemes once a week.

* Drainages should be cleaned in a while.

* Mud roads should be converted into cement roads.

* Government workers must educate the people about all these problems.

There were several awareness programmes that were carried out by the government of Andhra Pradesh and also at country level. They are being implemented at the rural level by the members of village saradarist. The programs are Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) or Total Sanitation Campaign.

The outcomes that were understood by the people are as follows like further cleaning and sanitising of all food contact surfaces and Good basic house keeping and maintainance. People are found to this.

People are improving and making their lives better by maintaining sanitation and also cleanliness.
