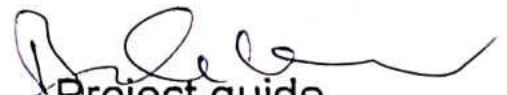

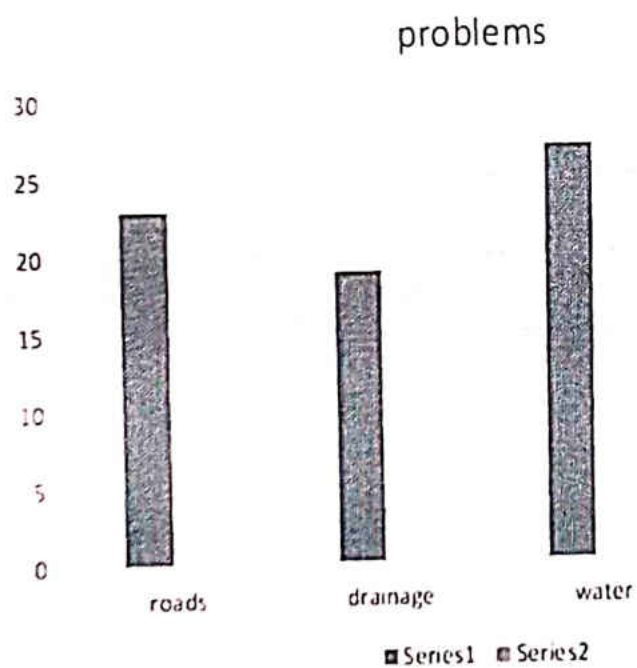
Problems identified
