The starting point for development of any sanitation system will normally be analysis of current problems often result from deep problems related to limited institutional capacity people's sanitation-related behaviour.

1. Develop an improved sanitation the planning is likely to identify some improvements that are obvious and affordable and can be implemented immediately.
2. Note the importance that it gives to monitoring and evaluation of plan execution and the use of that information to review progress.
3. By ensuring that people do not defecate in the open, one can completely eliminate such diseases and even more sleep ones such as the one.
4. Many of common diseases mentioned especially such as.
5. Obsolete forms of dangerous infectious diseases by keeping away snipe flies, mosquitoes and other pathogens.
6. Having clean fruits and egg related product in open areas pesticides dust and microbial resistance on them.
7. The problem is at it's impact in village where proper sanitation is not available.

villagers defecate in open, on busy busy labor railway tracks, fields and even directly in water. This cause water and soil pollution.

Moreover, it contaminates and affects ground water as well as surface water, resulting in diseases such as cholera, dysentery, typhoid, meningitis, hepatitis and dysentery.

Hygiene refers to conditions and practices that help to maintain health and prevent the spread of diseases.

Medical hygiene refers to a specific set of practices associated with this perception of health for example disinfection, cleaning, sterilization of equipment, hand hygiene, water and sanitation and safe disposal of medical waste.

To take care of all body parts includes in individual hygiene.

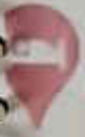
