

- ⇒ complete blood counting also known as a full blood count is a set of medical laboratory tests that provide information above the cells in a person's blood.
- ⇒ The CBC indicates the count of white blood cells red blood cells and platelets.
- ⇒ The concentration of haemoglobin and the hematocrit
- ⇒ Diseases can be detected in CBC - some of the common diseases CBC detect include anaemia bone marrow disorder dehydration infection.
- ⇒ normal range of white blood cells 4.500 to 11.000 4.5 million - 5.9 million cells / mcl for women
- ⇒ Haemoglobin 14 to 17.5 gram decaliter (g/dl) for men.


