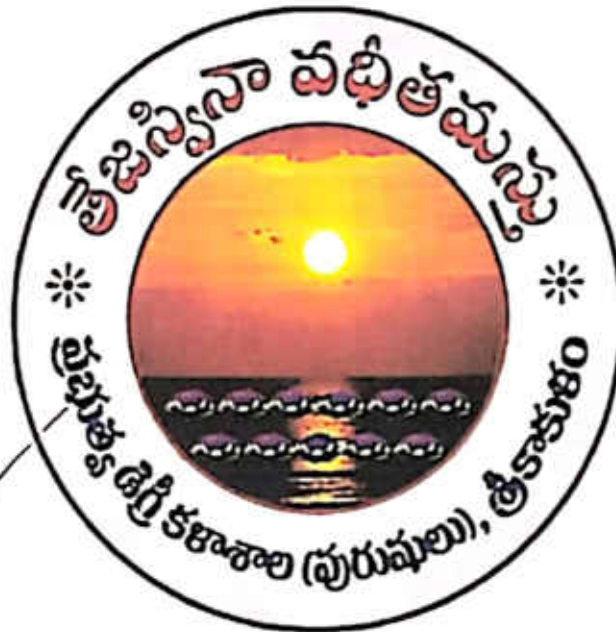

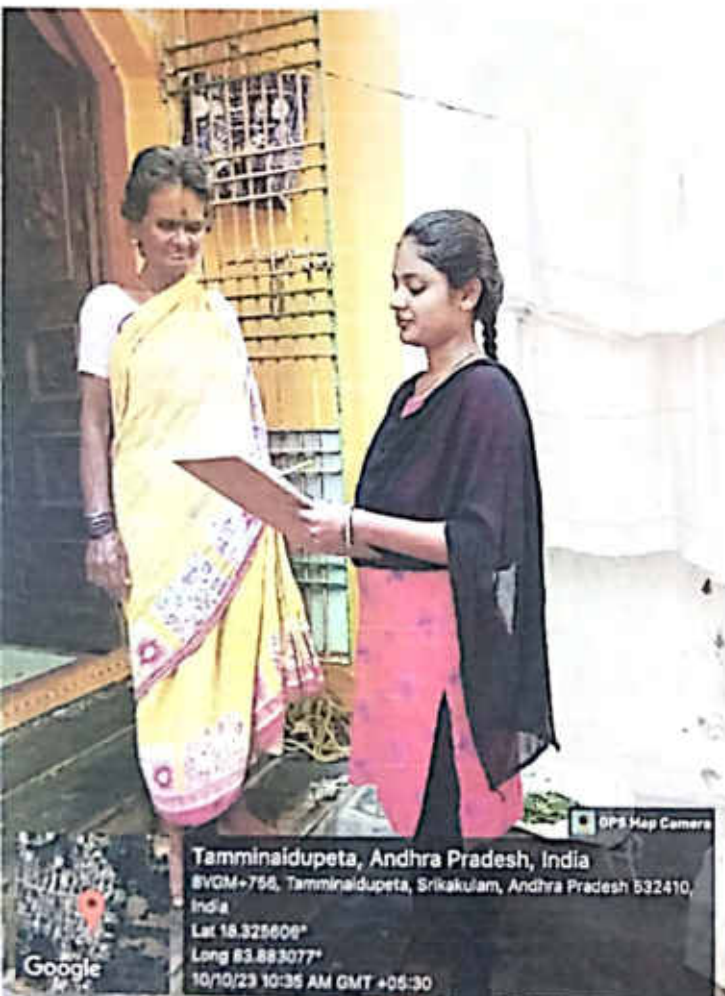
Precautions:

I am looking forward to holds the society in as many ways as possible. As we know small changes makes a huge difference. I will ever promote the idea of community service as a general responsibility for all.





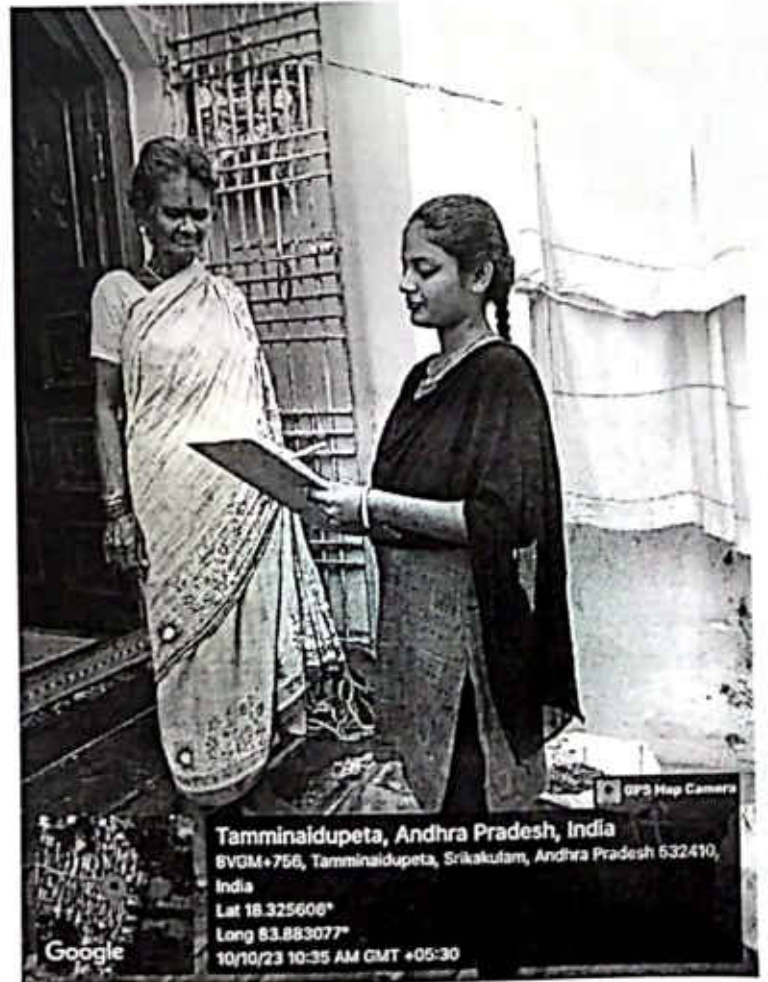


