

Background:-

Community service is a non-paying job performed by one person or a group of people for the benefit of their community or its institutions, community service is distinct from volunteering, since it is not always performed on a voluntary basis. It may be for a variety of reasons.

→ It may be required by a government as a part of citizenship requirements, like the mandatory "hard and hitch-up service" for some municipalities in Germany, or generally in lieu of military service or for civil reception services.

→ It may be required as a substitution of or in addition to, other criminal justice sanctionation. When performed for this reason, it may be referred to as community pay back.

→ In the UK, it has been made a condition of the receipt of certain benefits.

→ It may be mandated by schools to meet the requirements of a class, such as in the case of service learning or to meet the requirement of graduating as class valedictorian.

→ In Sweden it is a suspended sentence called "samhälstjänst" ["society service"].





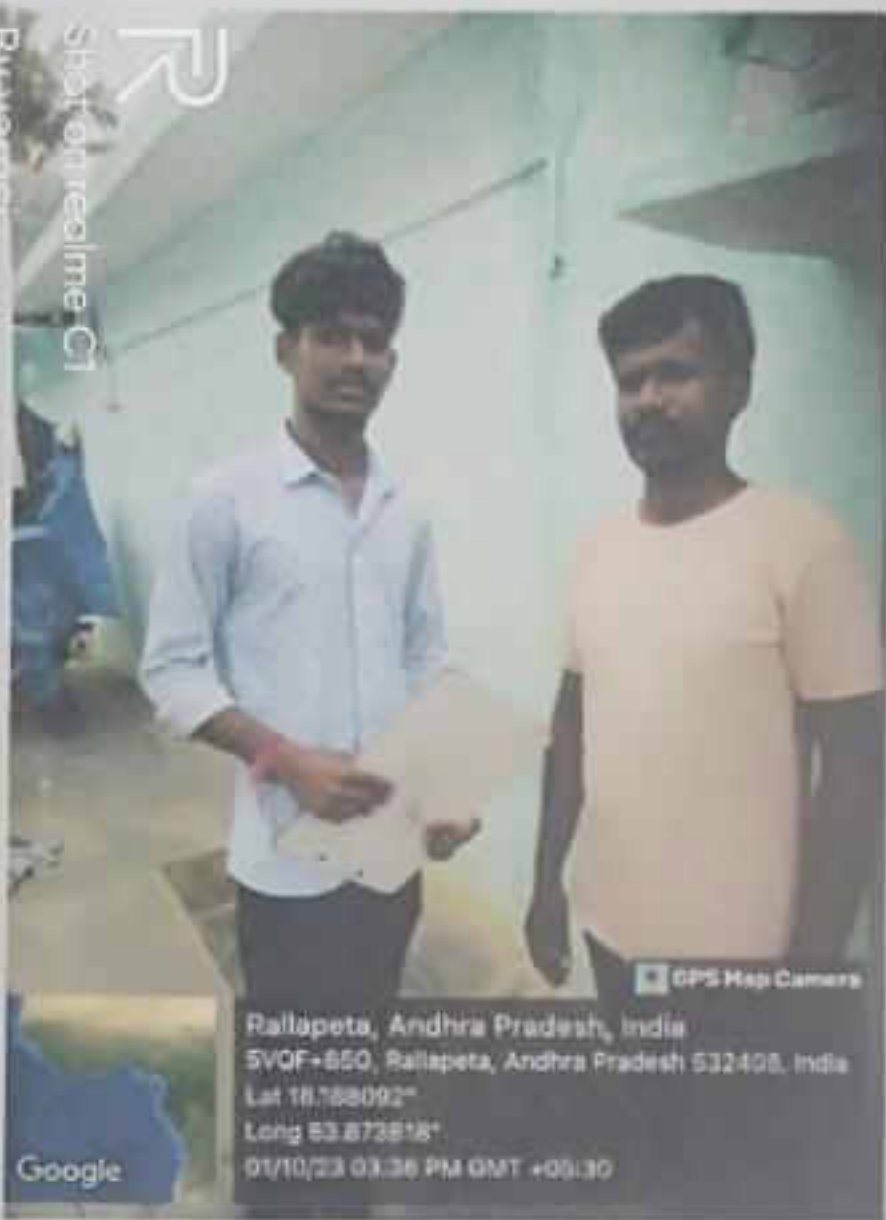
